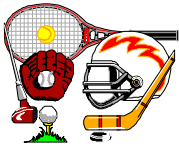

Fighting includes, but is not limited to, combative acts such as: An attempt to strike an opponent with a fist, hands, arms, legs or feet, whether or not there is contact; an attempt to instigate a fight by committing an unsportsmanlike act toward an opponent that causes an opponent to retaliate by fighting.
